Dear Church Family,

2 Peter 3:18: *“But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be the glory both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.”* That is my preaching theme for 2018. Good news is that what God commands, He supplies. God has graciously ordained and supplied the means to encounter the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and to grow in it through the Bible (Word), prayer, and sacraments.

It is easy to overlook the sacraments of baptism and the Lord's Supper as essential to growing in grace. I have been preaching of them and will continue to do so until we get to Palm Sunday. (March 25).

The Discipleship Committee has composed a helpful three-lesson study guide to better understand the sacraments based on the Bible and our confessions. It is concise and is designed to lead you to the heart of the sacraments. It is available in the Narthex where you get bulletins, the office, and in the Fellowship Hall. Please get one. Use it for study and prayer to deepen your understanding and apprehension of the sacraments.

WPC observes the Lord's Supper on the first Sunday of each month and on other special occasions. There will be communion at the Maundy Thursday service (March 29) as well as Easter morning, April 1. Our confessions make it plain how important the means of grace are:

Q. 85. What does God require of us, that we may escape his wrath and curse, due to us for sin?

A. To escape the wrath and curse due to us for sin, God requires of us faith in our Lord Jesus Christ and repentance leading to life, together with the diligent use of all the outward means by which Christ gives to us the benefits of redemption. Westminster Shorter Catechism

So let us diligently use the means God has provided to grow us up into the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ!
