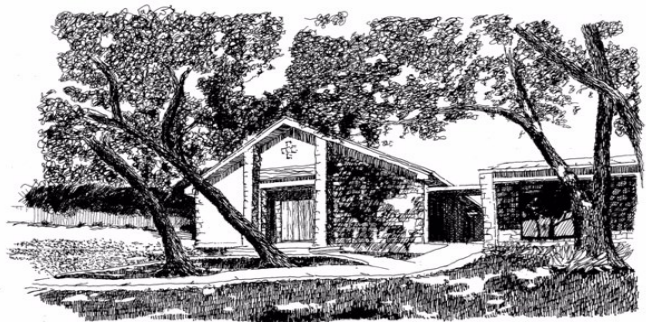

Dear Church Family,

You have heard and will hear a lot about prayer as a fight as we go through the sermon series on the Lord's Prayer. Colossians 4:12 is one of the key verses to support the idea of prayer as a fight or at least a "wrestling": **Colossians 4:12** "*Epaphras, who is one of you and a servant of Christ Jesus, sends greetings. He is always **wrestling** in prayer for you, that you may stand firm in all the will of God, mature and fully assured.*"

So what and for whom is Epaphras praying? He is praying for the people in his home church back in Colossae while he is away helping Paul in his missionary work. And he is wrestling in his prayers for them in three ways:

- 1) Standing firm in all the will of God-that they will stand firm in faith in the changes, blessings, and challenges of life
- 2) Mature-that they will grow in grace of Jesus Christ, and that they grow in wisdom and life
- 3) Fully assured-that they will be anchored in the unshakeable love of God for us in Christ

What would it be like to have a church full of people wrestling in prayer for each other like Epaphras did? Where do we begin?
