Dear Church Family,

Jason Helopoulos, a pastor in East Lansing, Michigan, relates a story from observing a first grade Sunday school class one morning. The teacher started in on the lesson of the call of the prophet Samuel in the Old Testament. She asked the class if anyone knew about the story and one little boy's hand shot up and he then began to recount the story in great dramatic detail including a loud rendition of God calling, "Samuel, Samuel!" After a few minutes he finished and the class sat spellbound. Finally, the teacher asked, "How do you know this story so well?"

To which little 6 year old Sam, replied, "Its about me!"
Well it isn't really about little Samuel. But he did something we should do sometimes, and that is to write ourselves into the story. No book in the New Testament invites us to do that quite like the book of Acts.

It's about how Jesus continues his ministry through the Holy Spirit in and through us. Acts is our story. It's our family history. It doesn't have a proper ending-on purpose. The Acts of the Holy Spirit are still being carried on in us! We are all Acts chapter 29. The chapter still being written until Jesus returns.

Come with expectant hearts and minds this fall as we explore the contours of our history and grapple with the Holy Spirit in the present.

To work for justice and peace, and


To build an inclusive, caring community of women
